

Nendawen Lodge 618 Lodge Executive Committee Meeting Minutes  
April 8, 2006

Attendance: There were a total of 17 OA members in attendance at this LEC meeting. Zach Baker, Jonathan Chambers Jonathan Fletcher, Michael Harlow, James Kochman, Travis O'Dell, and Jordan Stiers were not in attendance.

**Approval of January 7, 2006 Minutes**

A motion was made by Anthony Schoolcraft to approve the minutes of the January 7, 2006 officers meeting. The motion was seconded by Jacob Shifflett and was approved unanimously.

**Lodge Officer Updates and Reports**
